## Race and Site Information

**Fairway Gorge Paddling Club is proud to be presenting the First Ever X-Squared Women's 20-seat Dragon Boat Festival and XY Open 10-seat Dragon Boat Challenge!**

The **X-Squared Women's Festival** is a fun and competitive women's event, a first for Victoria. Races and festival activities will be held on and adjacent to Victoria's Gorge Waterway between the Selkirk Trestle and Bay Bridge. A variety of food choices, music and other activities and fun will be available in the paddlers' village area throughout the day. In addition, the 300-meter dragon boat races (guaranteed 3 races per team) will result in Platinum, Diamond, Jade, and Gold championship finals.

The **XY Open Championships** will have teams race twice against other open teams - once in a BUK and again in the Champion boats before advancing to the final medal rounds (in BUKs). Race times will be combined for an aggregate race time for placement, and the fastest teams advance to final race offs in the BUKs.

**The Stern's Meeting will be held at 9:30 am sharp**, on the upper deck at FGPC (in front of the gym). Team check-ins begin at 9:00 am. Bring any (final!) changes to your roster at that time. All paddlers must have a valid FGPC waiver completed or on file before participating in the event.

Races, as per the accompanying Race Schedule, begin at 10:00 am. Racing concludes by 3 pm.

All teams will be racing **THREE times** throughout the day: a placement heat, followed by a semi final and then a final. There will be four mixed championship (medal) races for X-Squared crews. There will be one championship (medal) race for XY Open crews.

It will be a busy and fun day of paddling!

Food trucks will be available with food and beverages for paddlers during the morning and afternoon. Please bring cash for these food trucks. Menus will be distributed by mid week.

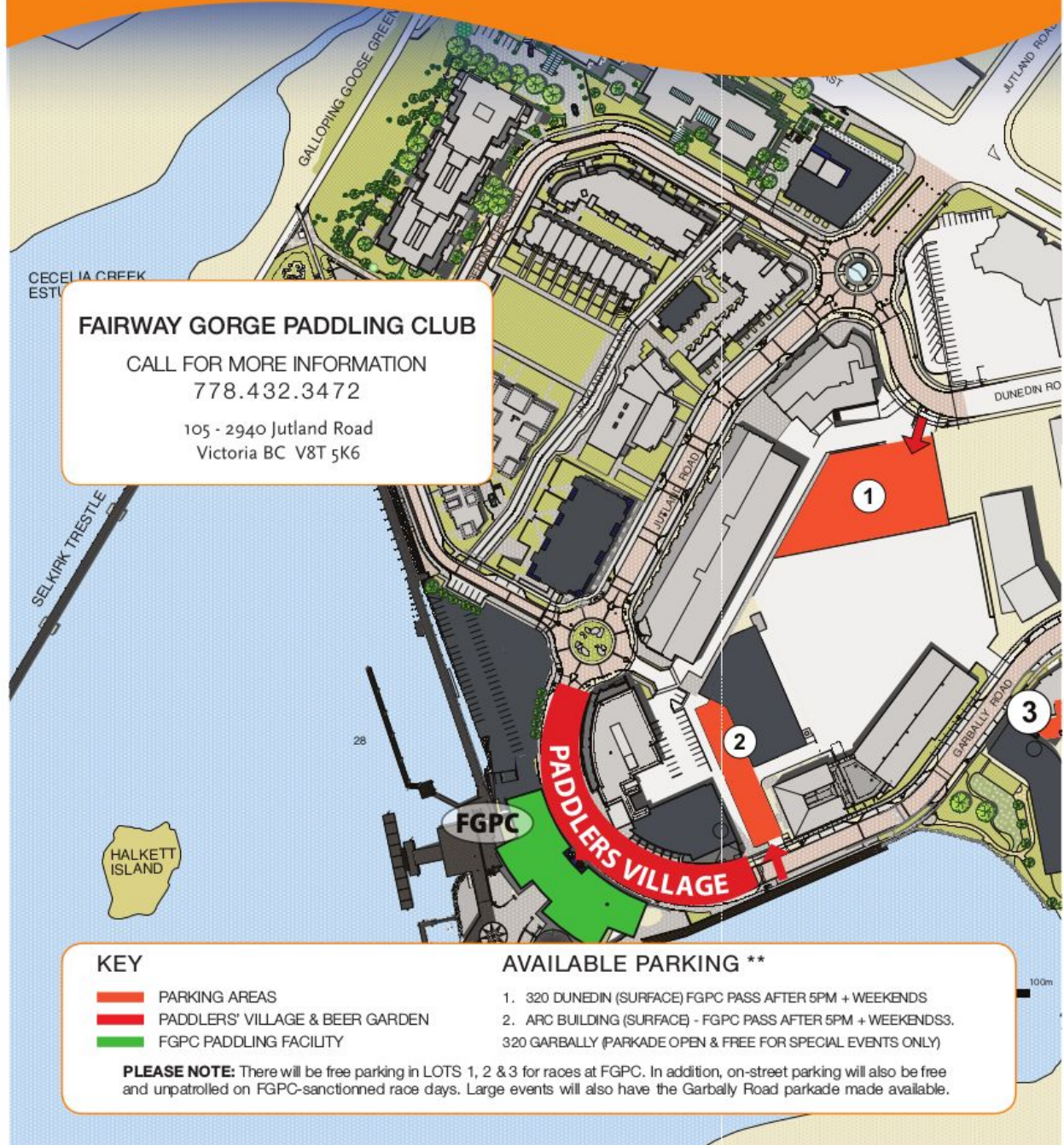
